

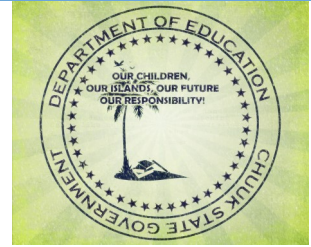

Annual Working Plan

The annual working plan for education took place in Yap August 30th to September 03, 2023. The working plan committee consists of members from all state department of education and national department of education. An annual working plan was developed merely to improve the quality of education in the states. Discussions were based on data regarding the National Minimum Competency Test (NMCT) and Accreditation results, with a specific focus on addressing the needs for teachers to pass the Teacher Competency Exam and National Standard Teacher Test.

This year's annual working plan is developed in hope to strike a balance between addressing immediate needs and working toward long-term educational improvement. It's essential to monitor progress regularly, adjust strategies as needed, and engage stakeholders, including educators, students, parents, and the community, to ensure the plan's success.

FEDSIS: Federated School Information System

A TOT – Training of Trainers workshop on Federal Student Information System – FedSIS was held for teachers and school admin staff at the Chuuk Department of Education - DOE on September 4th to September 9th 2023.

The Federal School Information System is a national database which holds school, teacher and student information. This training will help improve data collection, management and reporting both at the State and National DOEs.

Four (4) schools were selected to participate in the pilot TOT – Training of Trainers. The training workshop started on September 4th and ended on the 9th.
